The Rising Star Program is an excellent opportunity to generate professional contacts in Vancouver's theatre industry, expand one's technical knowledge and experience, and enjoy a wonderful summer under the stars in beautiful Stanley Park.

Ideal candidates will have experience related to their position and will show a keen interest in theatre and the arts. This internship requires a very strong time-commitment, especially in July and August.

The positions include:

***Assistant Stage Managers** (mentored by the Stage Manager)

Job description – any work assigned by the Stage Manager; prepare stage with set, props, etc.; work backstage moving set pieces, pulling curtains, etc. This position is highly important and directly impacts the successfulness of the show.

Time commitment – mid-May through late-August; for July and August, the ASM is contracted every other night from 6pm-11pm

***Lighting Operators** (mentored by Gerald King)

Job description – help with lighting set-up, as instructed by the Lighting Designer; operating one follow-spot

Time commitment – late-June through late-August; for July and August, the Lighting Operator is contracted every other night from 6pm-11pm

***Sound Operators** (mentored by Robin Boxwell)

Job description – help with sound set-up, as instructed by the Sound Designer; help set sound levels; help with sound mixing

Time commitment – late-June through late-August; for July and August, the Sound Operator is contracted every other night from 6pm-11pm

***Costume Builders** (mentored by Chris Sinosich)

Job description – help sew costumes; help with backstage costume changes throughout the show

Time commitment – early-May through late-August; for July and August, the Costume Builder is contracted every other night from 6pm-11pm

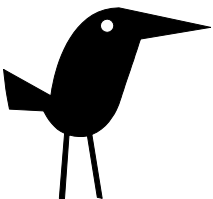
Props Builders (mentored by Yasu Shimosaka & Bibi Pedersen)

Job description – help find, build and modify props

Time commitment – mid-May through late-August

*Each Rising Star will be appointed to one show (either **Hairspray** or **Oliver!**) and must commit to every show through its full run (July 10-August 22 with possible holdover dates of August 23-29)
